If you didn't know, this month is Black History Month. Today's Black History Moment is about critically acclaimed Black Panther. The critically acclaimed Black Panther had great success its opening weekend bringing in 404 million dollars worldwide, making Black Panther the highest grossing film in history by a black director featuring a predominately black cast. In the decades since, Black Panther has undergone a variety of costume alterations and adventures in the comics, some under the direction of the filmmaker Reginald Hudlin, and more recently, the author Ta-Nehisi Coates. To direct the first Panther movie, Marvel tapped Ryan Coogler, who with his last outing, "Creed," shook the dust off the Rocky series by giving it an African-American champion played by Michael B. Jordan. For "Black Panther," Mr. Coogler brought

back both Mr. Jordan and some former crew members – including Rachel Morrison, the director of photography on his first feature “Fruitvale Station” – continuity that may help account for this movie’s intimacy and fluidity.
