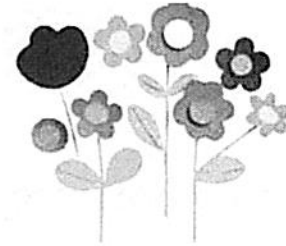

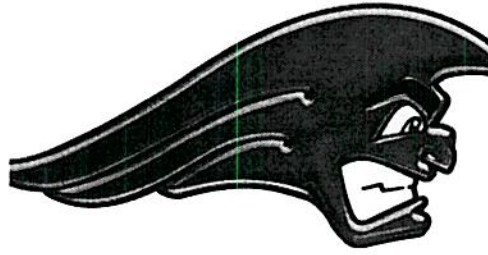
Mark your calendars!!!
