## Reading

Students will be determining the theme (moral) of a story. They will find text evidence to help determine the lesson that was learned and how it pertains to everyday living.

## Writing

This month, students are working on a research project called Christmas Around the World. Students will research Christmas traditions from a specific country and create a poster to present their information to the class.

## Word Work

Students' individual spelling lists focus on OrtonGillingham phonic concepts and red words (high frequency words). Spelling lists are given on Monday, activities to practice are incorporated throughout the week, and tests are on Friday. Grammar skills are also practiced daily using Mountain Language.
