Reading

After several weeks of studying theme, we will be reading stories that compare/contrast events in a story. Once that is completed, we will move on to Author's Point of View.

Writing

Students have just completed problem/solution writings. This month, they will be working on comparing/contrasting information in an article. Students are expected to use information from a given article, but generate sentences using mostly their own words to show how two things are alike and different.

Word Work

Students' individual spelling lists focus on Orton-Gillingham phonic concepts and red words (high frequency words). Spelling lists are given on Monday, activities to practice are incorporated throughout the week, and tests are on Friday. They are now learning skills to spell multisyllabic words. Grammar skills are also practiced daily using Mountain Language.
