January Newsletter

Reading

Students are continuing to work on determining the theme (moral or lesson) of passages read in class. Students are expected to be able to determine the theme and how it pertains to everyday living. Once we have completed theme, we will move on to comparing and contrasting passages.

Writing

This month, students will begin problem and solution writing. After reading a passage, students will determine and then discuss the problem and solution in their writing including an introduction, supporting details, and a conclusion.

Word Work

Students' individual spelling lists focus on Orton-Gillingham phonic concepts and red words (high frequency words). Spelling lists are given on Monday, activities to practice are incorporated throughout the week, and tests are on Friday. Grammar skills are also practiced daily using Mountain Language.

Reading Logs

Your child is expected to complete their monthly reading log. Each month there is a set number of minutes they are supposed to read. At the end of the month, please have your child add up the minutes they have read and sign their calendars. Grades will be administered for these.

Progress Book

The 2nd quarter grading period and 1st semester will end on January 12th. Since your child is receiving letter grades this year, we encourage parents/guardians to set up an account on Progress Book and check students' grades regularly. Grades will be updated weekly.
