Library Book Activities

- ➤ Name letters that your child may not have mastered yet and have your child point to them.
- ➤ Have your child find sight words that have been introduced on flash cards.
- ➤ Point to question marks, periods, commas, and quotation marks and have your child tell what they're called and why they're used.
- ➤ Who are the characters in the book?
- ➤ What is the setting (where the story takes place)?
- ➤ Is this book fantasy or reality?
- ➤ Retell the story...what happened in the beginning, middle, and end.
- ➤ Use two index cards as "curtains". Have your child start with one card to the left of a line of print and the other card on the right. Your child needs to then push the cards slowly together until all they can see is:
 - o one letter
 - o two letters
 - o one word
 - o two words
 - o the first letter of a word
 - o the last letter of a word
 - o a capital letter
