

Kindergarten News from Miss Rinderle

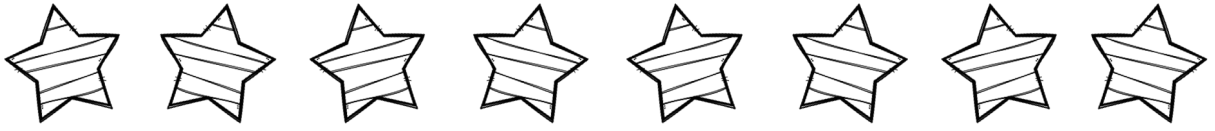
We have begun the school year with a great start! A newsletter will be sent home once a month. Attached to the newsletter are the sight word flash cards for the whole nine weeks. We will be learning one or two sight words each week. I would recommend cutting the flash cards apart and practicing the words that we have learned so far each night. Each week a sight word book is also introduced to the students. Your child will bring the book home to read to you for their reading log. After the book is read, put it back into their green folder to return back to school. The book will go into their bookbin to be read throughout the school day. The book can go home multiple days to continue practicing the sight words. I will be passing out the leveled readers to the students soon. These books have a colored edge. These books can go home to be read, but just like the sight word books, please send them back to school for your child to put in his or her bookbin.

If you have not signed up for the app "Seesaw" yet, I would encourage you too. You will already find a few pictures of your child from the first days of school and your child will learn how to send pictures to you as soon as he/she receives their school iPad. Let me know if you need another paper sent home with directions of how to sign up.

Remember to check your child's folder each night and to take all work out of the "Keep at Home" side of the folder and to check the behavior chart to see how his or her day went.
