Please take a few minutes to read about the standards we will be learning this month.

Math- This month the students will be learning about area and perimeter. When given the area or perimeter of a shape, they need to be able to find the unknown measure of the length or width.

In addition, they will learn about two-dimensional shapes and their characteristics. Students need to be able to identify parallel lines and perpendicular lines. They also need to be able to identify acute, obtuse, and right angles. They will learn to use protractors to measure angles.

Social Studies- For the last couple of weeks, we have been learning about the Revolutionary War. The students enjoyed a tax simulation using Skittles to help them understand taxation without representation. We will continue to learn about the causes and effects of the war. A study guide will be sent home prior to the test at the end of the month.

Science- We just finished our energy unit. The students enjoyed building wind turbines and competing to see which one could lift the most pennies.
