

# College Visits

Students are encouraged to take college visits starting their Junior year. Juniors are allowed one college visit day a year and Seniors are allowed two college visit days. College visit day forms are in the guidance office. We encourage students to visit several different types of colleges, which also offer different price points. To take a college visit you sign up on the individual college websites. Once you pull up the college website click on the Visit Campus button to schedule the date and time that works best for you and your family.

## Community Colleges:

Colleges that offer Short Term and Long-Term Certificates, Two Year Associates Degrees and University Parallel Programs (completing the first two years of academics to transfer to the four-year university). Students commute to community colleges. **Edison and Sinclair** are the two-year community college options locally.

## Regional Campuses:

A regional campus is part of a larger university system but has its own separate campus. Regional campuses offer mostly four-year Bachelor's Degrees. The campuses are much smaller than the main campus of the university and offers a lower tuition rate. The most popular regional campuses our students attend include **IU East and Wright State Lake Campus**. Many regional campuses also offer housing options.

## Four Year Universities:

A four-year university offers undergraduate bachelor's degrees and master's degrees. Campuses also offer onsite student housing and often require students live on campus for one or two years. The cost of a four-year university is the most expensive option. When looking up pricing be sure you are including tuition and room and board cost if you will be living on campus.
