### Option 2: Enlist in the Military

Show evidence that you have signed a contract to enter a branch of the U.S. armed services upon graduation.

### Option 3: Complete College Coursework

Earn credit for one college-level math and/or college-level English course through Ohio’s free college Credit Plus program
