Military

- Get contact information for your local recruiting office from the Guidance Office

Trade School

- Research adult programs at MVCTC, Upper Valley JVS, Sinclair and Edison on their websites
- Research specific trade schools on google for specific career interest
- Fill out the application and have a funding plan for the program of choice (fill out the FAFSA)
 - Attend FAFSA Completion Night
- Request information from the guidance department as needed for admissions requirement to be met, such as a transcript.

Community College: Associate's Degree or University Parallel Program (Transfer Model)

- Research programs at Sinclair and Edison to find out what fits your career path:
 - Attend Edison Field Trip
- Fill out the application online or update your application status
- Let your counselor know what forms need submitted, such as a transcript.
- Develop a financial plan
 - Attend Financial Aid Night
 - Attend FAFSA Completion Night

4-year University

- Re-take the ACT if necessary (most schools are test-optional)
- Attend the Senior Financial Aid night and FAFSA Completion Night
- Go on College Visits (College Visit Day form is available in the Guidance office).
- Follow the Basic College Checklist (Can be obtained in the guidance office).
- Fill out an official application.
- See your school counselor with information that they will have to submit on your behalf
